When you come to your audition, please have a one-to-two minute monologue memorized. We prefer that the monologue be in verse from an early modern play (Shakespeare or contemporaries). Dress to move, bring water, and expect to stay for 30-60 minutes. All auditionees will need to submit proof of COVID vaccination.
